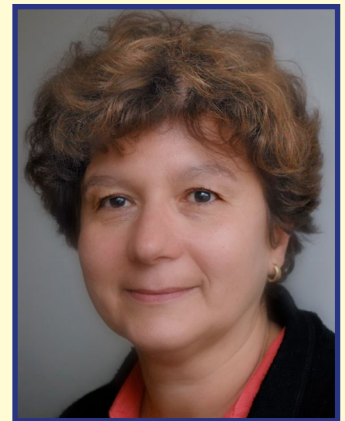

Our contribution to the construction and the correct maintenance of databases such as ORCID, ResearcherID, Scopus and PEOPLE, with accurate information on our work is of fundamental importance to remove any misunderstandings on our identity and scientific production. In fact, informatic procedures require that exactly coded information is included within a database. It is, therefore, of fundamental importance the contribution by researchers to this work.

Particularly, the use of the ORCID code identifier, which unambiguously attributes to authors their own research products, was recently requested by CNR for ANVUR and will more and more be required by scientific journals and to participants in projects.
